## Advantages:

- High yielding variety with very good straw stability
- Best resistance package, especially high mildew resistance
- Low fusarium risk
- Good sieving, high specific weight and high kernel content

## Cultivation:

Typical locations for growing oats, widely adaptable

---- = very low resistance/early/short,

++++ = very high resistance/late/long
