

GROWING ADVICE:

- Use a moderate seed rate, crop will tiller well
- Sowing should be between early September – middle/end of October (dependent on conditions). Rye is weak at emergence so drilling into the winter can reduce establishment
- The crop presents impressive spring vigour. Close management of nutrition and PGR applications is required

UNIQUE SELLING POINTS (USP)

- Hybrid technology – gives advantages over conventional varieties
- Excellent results as a grain rye – high protein levels. Feed market
- Highest nitrogen to protein conversion than any other rye

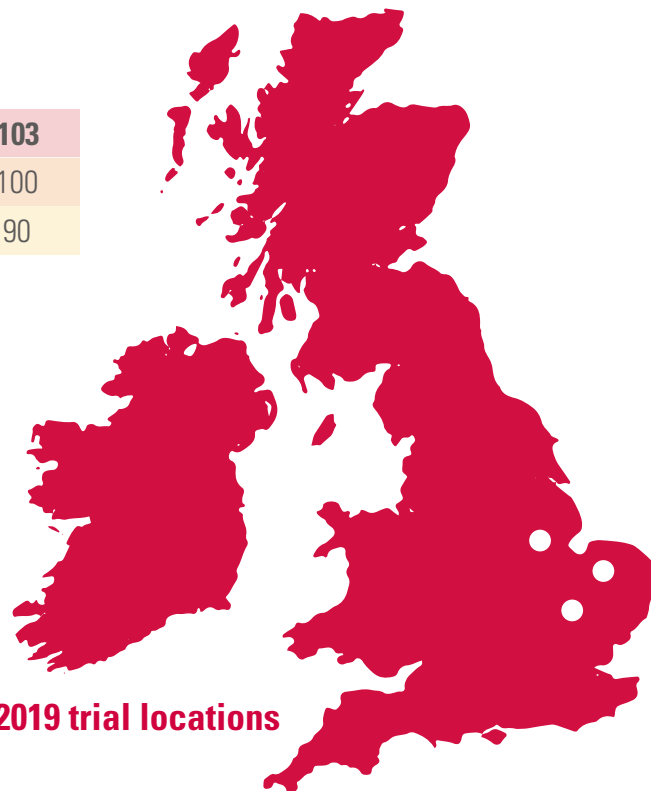
